



Announcement of the College of Management, Mahidol University
on No Gift Policy
Fiscal Year B.E. 2569 (2026)

Whereas Mahidol University has established the No Gift Policy for Fiscal Year B.E. 2569 (2026), in alignment with the National Reform Plan for Corruption Prevention and Suppression on the No Gift Policy of the Office of the Public Sector Anti-Corruption Commission (PACC).

To ensure the effective and concrete implementation of Mahidol University's No Gift Policy for Fiscal Year B.E. 2569 (2026), the College of Management, Mahidol University, hereby issues this Announcement as follows:

Clause 1 The College declares itself as **“an organization in which every government official does not accept gifts or any kind during/before/after performing their duty.”** This is to prevent corruption.

Clause 2 The College has issued a No Gift Policy to be followed by the government officials working for the College as follows:

2.1 Personnel shall not accept gifts, benefits, or any kind of payment for performing their duty.

2.2 Personnel shall not offer gifts, benefits, or any kind to outside people contracting the College.

2.3 Personnel shall neither accept nor offer gifts, benefits of any kind from/to persons, organizations, working units, or companies that are, or might be, partners or contracting parties of the College, relating to any form of procurement.

2.4 Personnel shall not pursue or perform any acts to obtain gifts or other benefits that are illegal.

2.5 As for accepting or offering gifts as a part of traditions and conventionality or to show good manners, it should be considered according to appropriateness. The value of the gifts or benefits, however, shall not exceed 3,000 Baht or

beyond the legal limit. Be careful not to undervalue the gifts and benefits to be lower than their actual ones.

2.6 Personnel of the College shall convey expressions of congratulations, good wishes, welcome, or condolences on various occasions through greeting cards, condolence books, or social networking platforms, rather than giving gifts.

Clause 3 Executives, supervisors, and heads of all units are responsible for emphasizing and communicating the policy issues in this announcement to their personnel in a concrete manner, with the aim of having personnel follow the policy strictly.

This announcement is effective from the date of issuance.
